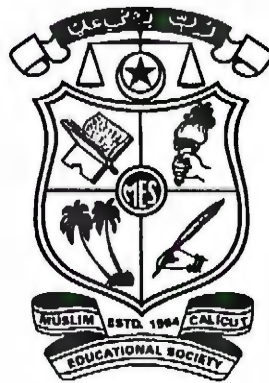

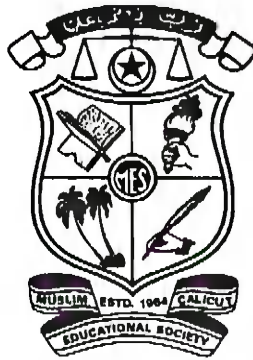

## **Jalakam Extension Programme**

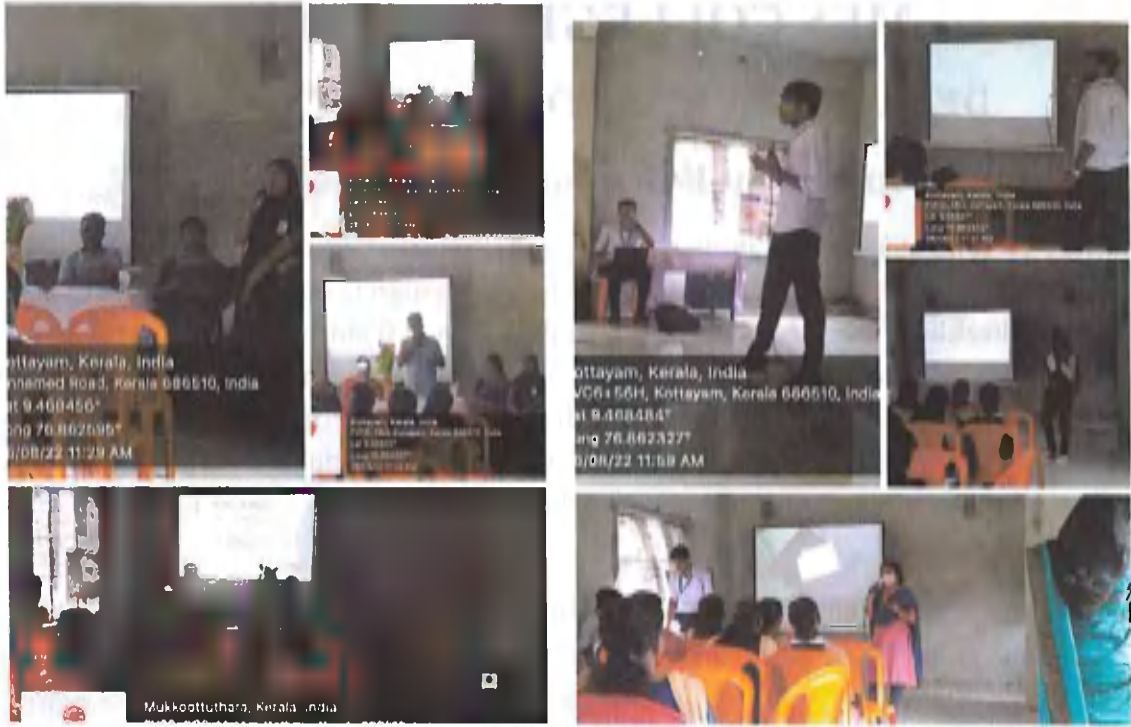
