These are persuasive article writing and expository article writing.

The most important among the types of article writing is SEO article writing. It has gained huge demand for this new generation. SEO article writing is nothing but the search engine optimization of the article that is written. The question that may arise here is how one can ensure that one's article has achieved its goal. Keywords refer to important words of the article that could be used several times in a paragraph or in the article to highlight the importance of the word.



The second session was handled by Dr.Rakhi Chandrasekhar (HOD of the Department of Economics). She explained the different ways of Paper Presentation. She gave some tips for PowerPoint Presentation: Be brief and concise. Focus on the subject. Attract attention; indicate interesting details.

If possible, use relevant visual illustrations (pictures, maps, charts, graphs, etc.).Use bullet points or numbers to structure the text.Make clear statements about the essence/results of the topic/research.

INTRODUCTION

According to Article 112 of the Indian Constitution, the Union Budget of a year, also referred to as the annual financial statement, is a statement of the estimated receipts and expenditure of the government for that particular year. The Union Budget of India for 2020–2021 was presented by the Finance Minister, NirmalaSitharaman on 1 February 2020, as her second budget. This is the second budget of NarendraModi-led NDA government's second term. The Economic Survey for 2019–2020 was released on 31 January 2020, a day before the budget.

The central ideas of the Budget are "Aspirational India, Economic development, A Caring Society". These three broad themes are connected by governance that is corruption free and a financial sector that is clean and sound.Notably, NirmalaSitharaman read out a Kashmiri poem[a] during the budget speech in the Parliament, a Tamil couplet written by Thiruvalluvar and a verse from the Sanskrit work Raghuvamsam as well as a French phrase. Some of the aims announced were "improving digital governance, physical quality of life, disaster resilience and social security reach".

At 2 hours and 41 minutes, the budget speech was the longest ever delivered by a Finance Minister of IndiaNirmalaSitharaman is also only the second woman to present the budget for a second time after Indira Gandhi.Quiz competition on

budget helps the students to understand the efficient governance and factors that help to achieve economic stability in the country.

Report of quiz competition

In association with IQAC, the Department of Economics had conducted a Quiz Competition on Union Budget 2020 for the students of various departments of our institution. Before the competition news bulletin on Union Budget 2020 was circulated to all departments. The competition was held on 6th February 2020 from 10.30 A.M to 12.30 P.M. 30 teams were registered and 28 teams participated. 5 were selected from these 28 teams through a screening test for the final rounds. Bijitha and Gayathri Mohan of 1st year M.Com Finance & Taxation and Anju Maria Varghese &Abhilash Christy D.S of 2nd year MSW won the first and second prize respectively.
