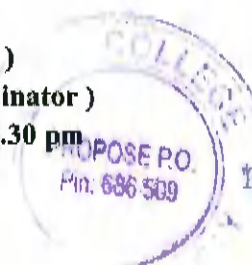

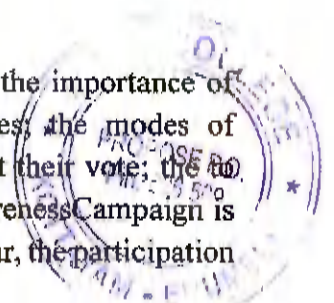


DISCUSSION SECTION

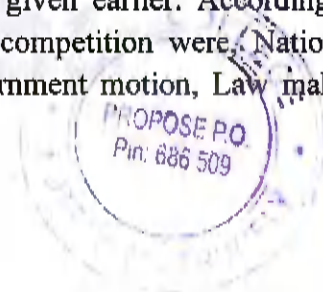

MOCK PARLIAMENT 2021

The parliamentary affairs and electoral literacy club MES college has conducted a mock parliament competition on 9/04/2021 at 12.00 pm in the college seminar hall. The program was steered with the regards of Mr.Jithesh Sivaramapillai IQAC & Academic director of MES college and Miss.Anjala Ayub khan Coordinator of the program and one of the faculty members Department of B.com. The main aim of the program was to create a good awareness among the students about the functioning of Parliament. First, the coordinators created a Whatsapp group of students who wanted to be a part of it . Both UG,PG, students from various departments joined the group and discussions were conducted. All these helped to create awareness about competition among the students.

The event started with an introduction by the coordinator Miss.Anjala Ayub Khan .There were two teams to compete ,the first team was from the MSW department consisting of 22 members. Second team was from the MCom department with 20 members. The first team was selected by lott. According to that, the department of social work got the opportunity to participate first. It was a mini form of the parliament with the president, the prime minister and other members. The competition was conducted according to the guidelines given earlier. Accordingly, the time allotted to a team was 30 minutes. Schedules of the competition were, National Anthem, Presidential Address, Oath-taking, Question Hour,Adjournment motion, Law making and the section ended with the national anthem.



Each group consists of the Speaker, President, the Prime Minister, 4 Ministers, the Leader of the Opposition, one Member of the Opposition presenting the Adjournment motion, 7 members of the ruling party (MP), 7 members of the Opposition (MP), one member to be sworn in from the Opposition and two guard.

Due to some inconvenience we didn't get the time for proper preparation for the competition. However, through the collective efforts of all, we were able to put in a good performance. We watched various mock parliament videos as part of the competition and all of that helped us to know more about that. We also conducted a pre-arranged performance in the class in a short period of time with the presence of our faculties. According to that, each student has taken a different position. Some of them voluntarily demanded the position which they wanted to perform as a member of the parliament. According to that, Speaker was Shedha, President was Akhil J Jacob, Prime Minister was Ananthu Ravi, Secretary General was Amrita, Opposition party leader was Shifaas, Ruling party members were Navya venu (Finance minister), Sangeetha Sajeevan (Health Minister), Josna Joseph (Agriculture), Gayathri (MP), Silla (MP), Jayalakshmi (MP), Aswathy (MP), Amith Lal Dious (MHRD) and 7 opposition party members were Devika Mohan, Albiya shaji, Sreelakshmi, Bincy Raj B R, Shifaas, Achu Mol Tom, Abin D kumar. Chinju Vijayan and Sreedevi took the role of Guard.

Parliament began its functions under the chairmanship of the Speaker. The swearing in of the new MP took place after the President's presidential address. During the question hour session, questions were raised by the Opposition and answers were received from the ruling party. A member of the Opposition introduced the adjournment motion. A representative of the ruling party replied. After that MHRD Minister introduced the bill to ensure reservation of LGBTQ Community. There were discussions about it. The speaker said the bill was approved by a majority of the ruling party. The session then adjourned with the Speaker's concluding speech. Both teams followed the same criteria and everyone tried to make their part better. The performances during the question hour is well articulated. We were able to make the most out of the opportunity where we get. From the feedback from the audience and the general analysis section, it was clear that both teams participated well. After that, Jithesh Sir spoke about the mock parliament and also about the need to organise such a competition among students.

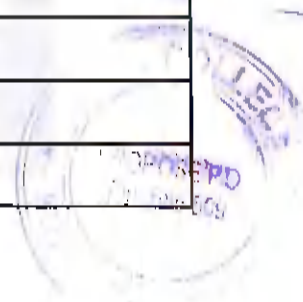

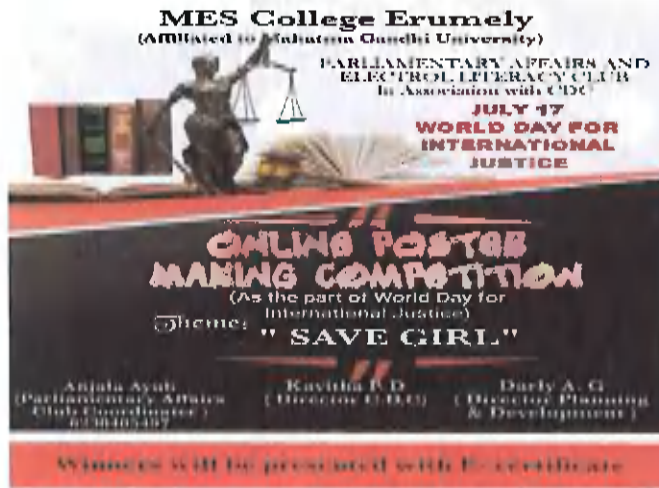
ONLINE POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

The Winner of the competition was Sruthi Mol (2 year B. Com Marketing)

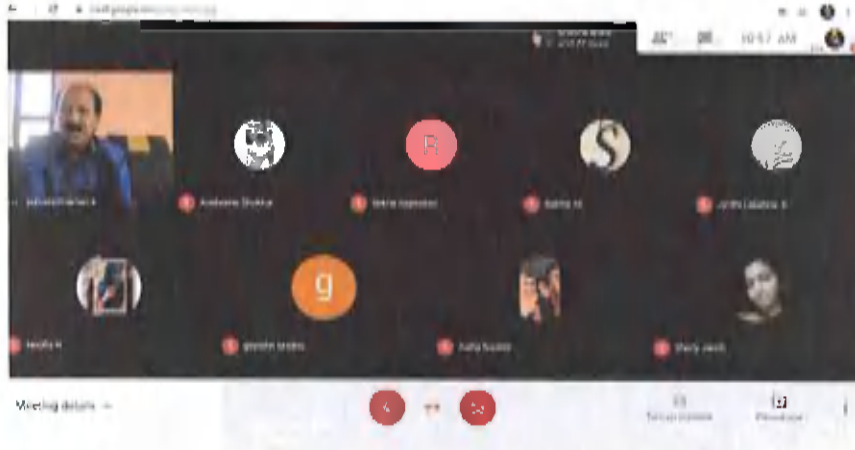




“ AWARENESS ON INDIAN PARLIAMENTARY SYSTEM ”

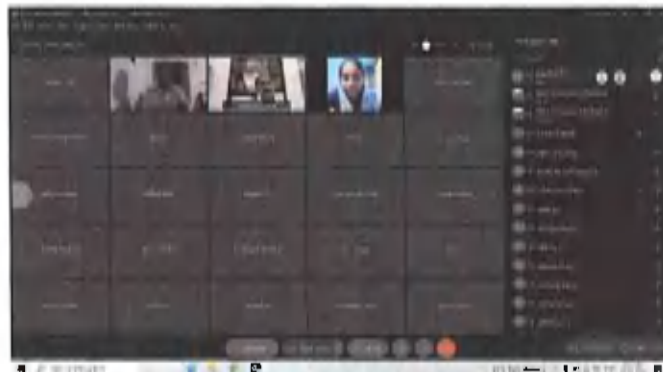

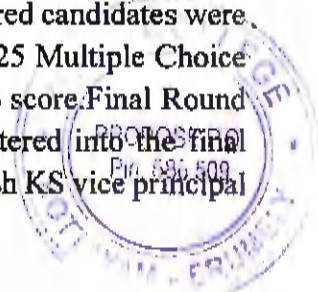


QUIZ CLUB

UNION BUDGET- 2020

According to Article 112 of the Indian Constitution, the Union Budget of a year, also referred to as the annual financial statement, is a statement of the estimated receipts and expenditure of the government for that particular year. The Union Budget of India for 2020–2021 was presented by the Finance Minister, Nirmala Sitharaman on 1 February 2020, as her second budget. This is the second budget of Narendra Modi-led NDA government's second term. The Economic Survey for 2019–2020 was released on 31 January 2020, a day before the budget. The central ideas of the Budget are "Aspirational India, Economic development, A Caring Society". These three broad themes are connected by governance that is corruption free and a financial sector that is clean and sound.

Notably, Nirmala Sitharaman read out a Kashmiri poem during the budget speech in the Parliament, a Tamil couplet written by Thiruvalluvar and a verse from the Sanskrit work Raghuvamsam as well as a French phrase. Some of the aims announced were "improving digital governance, physical quality of life, disaster resilience and social security reach".

At 2 hours and 41 minutes, the budget speech was the longest ever delivered by a Finance Minister of India. Nirmala Sitharaman is also only the second woman to present the budget for a second time after Indira Gandhi. Quiz competition on budget helps the students to understand the efficient governance and factors that help to achieve economic stability in the country. In association with IQAC, the Department of Economics had conducted a Quiz Competition on Union Budget 2020 for the students of various departments of our institution. Before the competition news bulletin on Union Budget 2020 was circulated to all departments. The competition was held on 6th February 2020 from 10.30 A.M to 12.30 P.M. 30 teams were registered and 28 teams participated. 5 were selected from these 28 teams through a screening test for the final rounds. Bijitha and Gayathri Mohan of 1st year M.Com Finance & Taxation and Anju Maria Varghese & Abhilash Christy D.S of 2nd year MSW won the first and second prize respectively.





Certificates were distributed to winners.

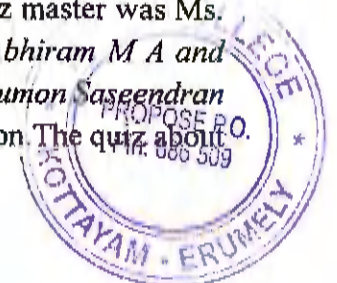

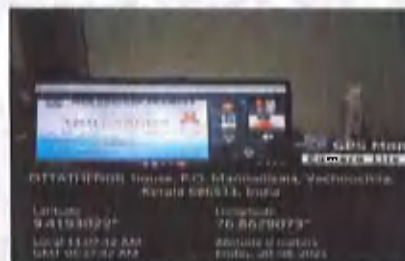


QUIZARDS

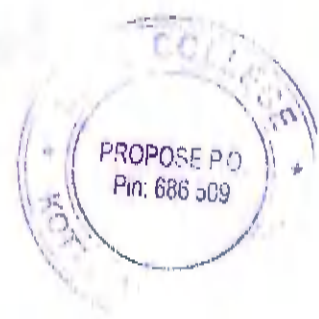

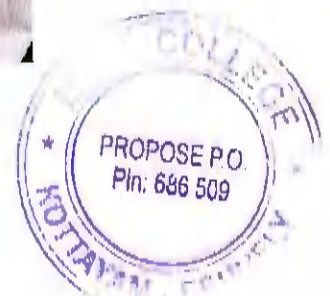

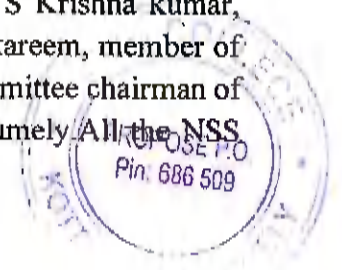
INDEPENDENCE DAY

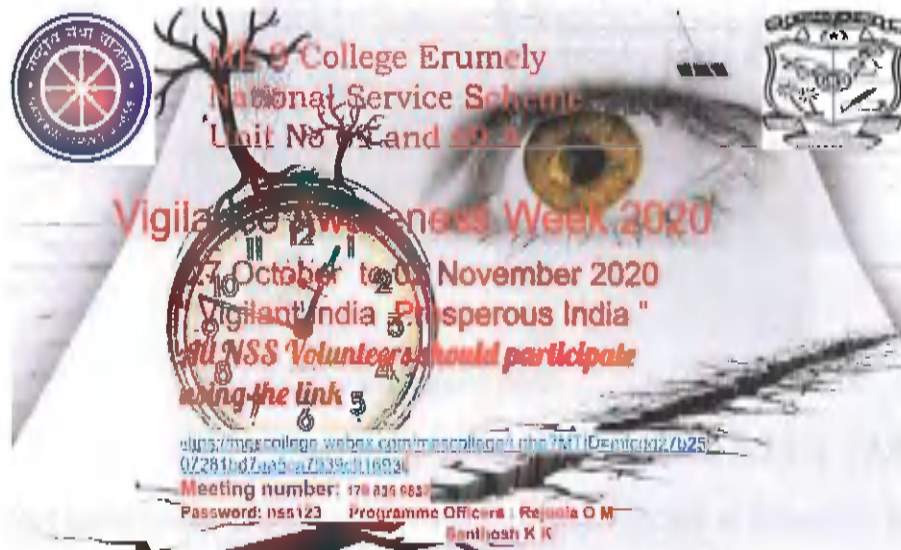
REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

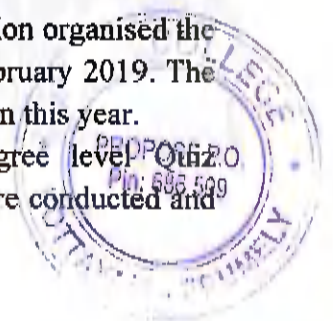


NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY

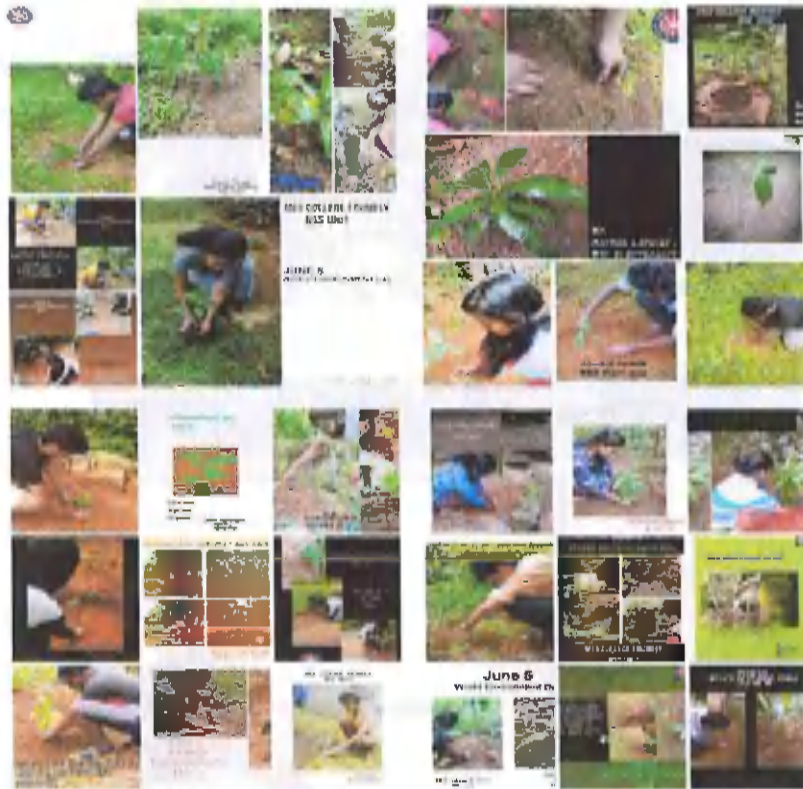
ARMY DAY

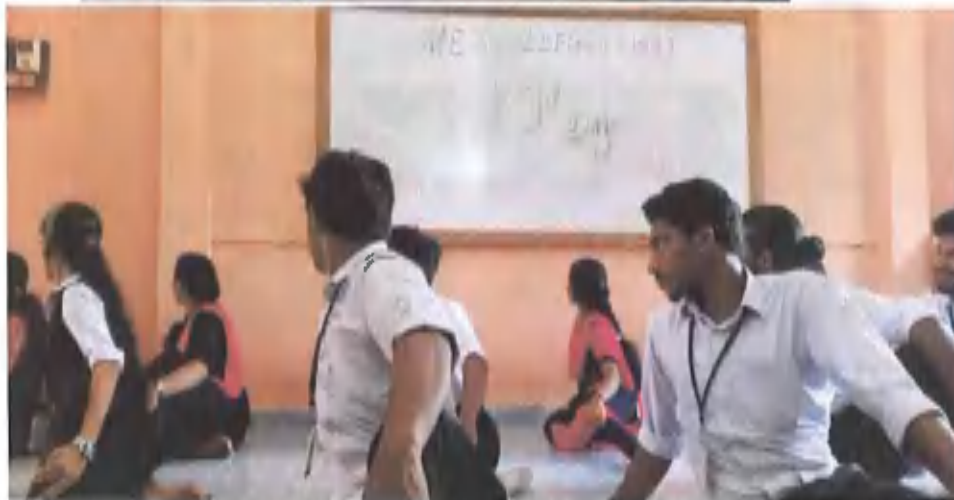
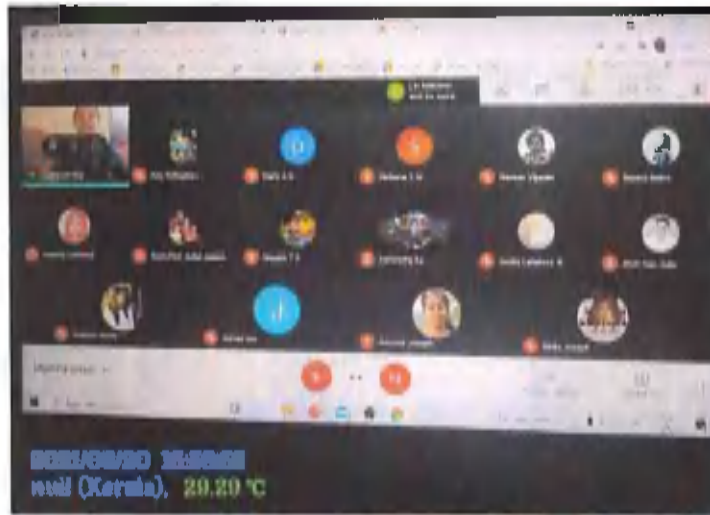




INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
