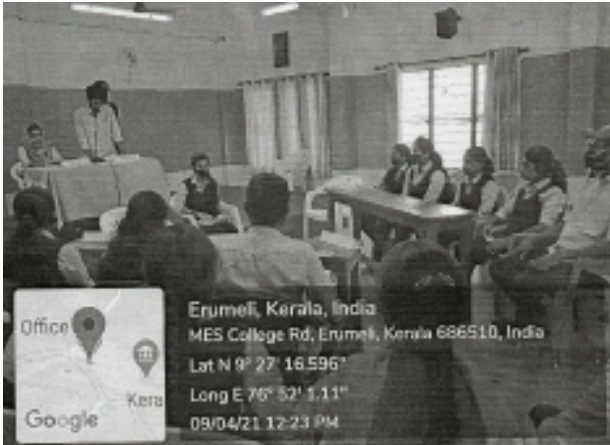

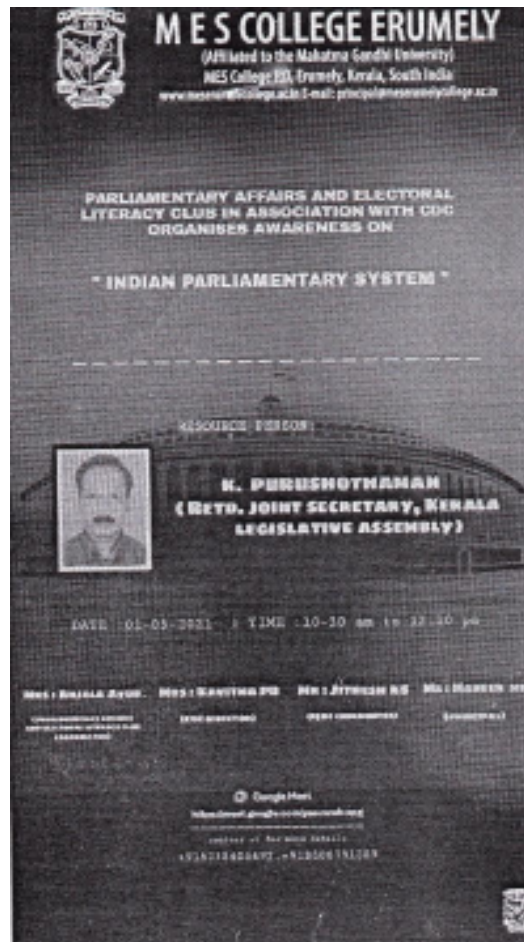

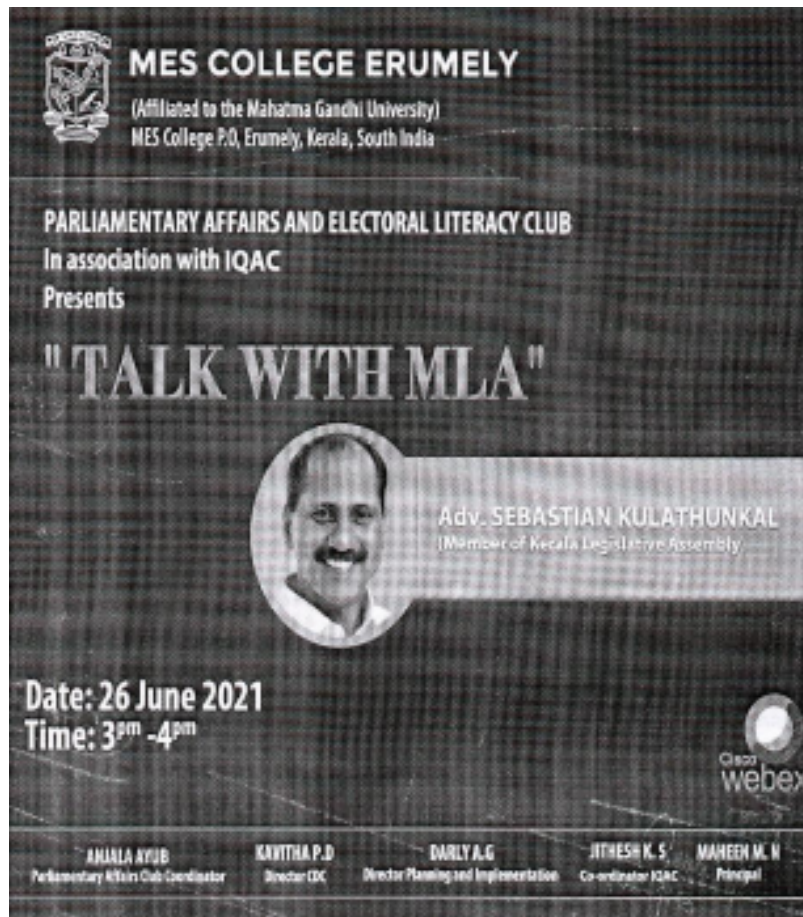
AWARENESS ON INDIAN PARLIAMENTARY SYSTEM

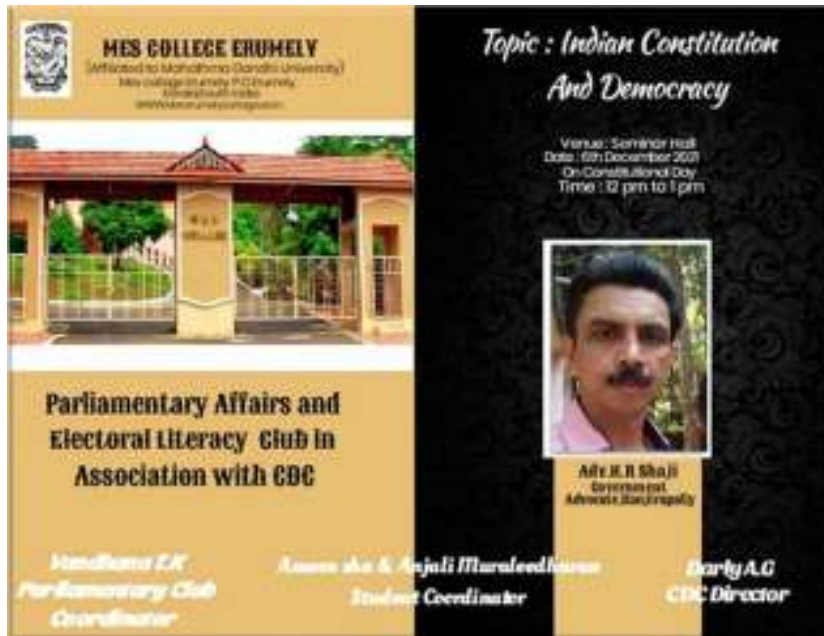
TALK WITH MLA
