#### **Activity-1**

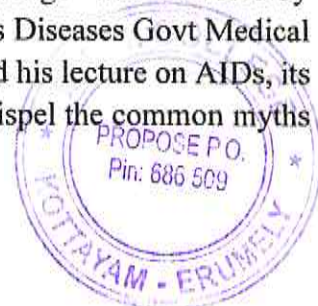
