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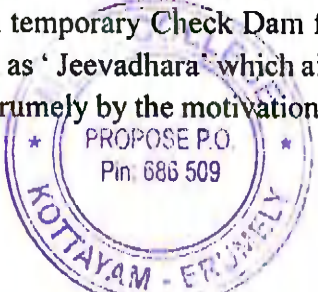

Volunteers day and Night Efforts in toilet construction

The NSS volunteers actively participated in the construction of the toilet . The volunteers take leadership in the different tasks associated with the completion of the construction.

Volunteers Efforts for fundRaising

The NSS Volunteers in the college selected a day for fundraising . One day, the NSS Unit collected 40,0000.00 rupees. The volunteers donated the collected fund for constructing toilets . This report is based on construction of a temporary Check Dam for drought control by NSS units. The NSS unit initiated a project known as ' Jeevadhara' which aims to control the chance of drought through constructing Check dam in Erumely by the motivation from the district collector. inaugurated by the Ward member Sri Subrahmanian and the meeting was conducted in Erumely Valiyathodu. The project was presided by Sri V G Harishkumar, NSS programme officer and on that day 120 volunteers participated actively. The project was conducted based on the problem faced by the people in Erumely in summer, related to drinking water and this was identified by our Nss unit which led us to conduct the Check dam construction project. We constructed a temporary Check dam in Erumely Valiyathodu to increase the water storage level in the area even in summer season. The project was conducted and completed without any financial help from any agencies. The unit also organised and implemented a scientific study related to water scarcity and other related issues in the project area and identified that women are mostly affected by water related issues. The volunteers interviewed 73 families as part of the area study. Apart from the Check dam construction the NSS unit organised a river cleaning programme before starting the project. This helps to avoid plastics and other wastes from contamination of the project area. The temporary Check dam construction and river cleaning were completed through this programme. The success behind this project was the Will power and the NSS man power of the volunteers.

BLOOD DONATION CAMPAIGN

Regular Blood Donation

The NSS unit organised blood donation camps in association with Govt. Medical College Blood Bank, Kottayam. The volunteers created a blood donation forum under the NSS unit and actively undertook blood donation initiatives by all the volunteers.

Regular Blood Donor of Medical College, Kottayam

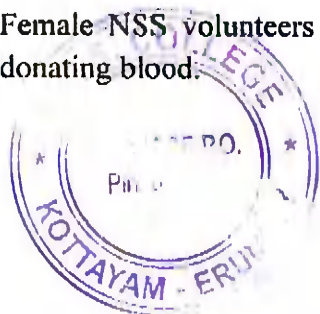
The NSS unit organised 4 blood donation camps in association with Govt. Medical College, Kottayam. As part of the blood donation activities of the unit the Kerala State Blood Transfusion Council (KSBTC) submitted an Award as part of the world blood donation day celebration at Kottayam. The Award to the unit was submitted by Sri. Mons Joseph MLA at an important meeting of Kerala State Health Department at Kottayam CMS College.

Regular Blood Donation - Awareness Generation among Volunteers

The NSS unit organised awareness generation campaign regarding the significance of blood donation among NSS volunteers with the support of Hindustan Latex Family Planning Promotion Trust (HLFPPT), Taluk Voluntary Blood Donation Forum, and Peace Mission. The programme resulted in positive changes in the mindsets of NSS volunteers regarding blood donation. As a result every NSS volunteer of the unit became blood donors. They are alert to give their blood for saving 4 lives at a chance.

Female Volunteer Participation

Female NSS volunteers should be appreciated because they have high level participation in donating blood.



Free Health Check up

The NSS volunteers of the college donate their blood every three months so that they can have a free complete medical check up. It consists of BMI, various blood tests, HIV/AIDS test, Malaria test etc. Through the blood donation NSS Volunteers are regularly monitoring their health status besides the immense service to the nation. KSBTC issues a blood donation certificate to the volunteers and the certificate will be valid for three months. With the help of the particular certificate the kin relatives of the Volunteers can receive blood on a free of cost form the Govt. Blood Banks of Kerala in case of emergency.

Blood Donation - A Record in Kottayam District

The two blood donation camps of the college collected blood from 213 NSS volunteers (106+107), so that it was a record blood donation camp when considering the distance from the medical college and the rural characteristics. The media reported the facts with great importance. Now the NSS Unit has 200 volunteers who are ready to give blood for any time, any circumstances on a free of cost.

KSBTC Award for Blood Donation

Kerala State Blood Transfusion Council (KSBTC) honoured the NSS Unit for organising the maximum number of blood donation camps in the college in association with Govt. Medical College, Kottayam. The Award was distributed by Sri. Mons Joseph MLA at a meeting at CMS College, Kottayam.

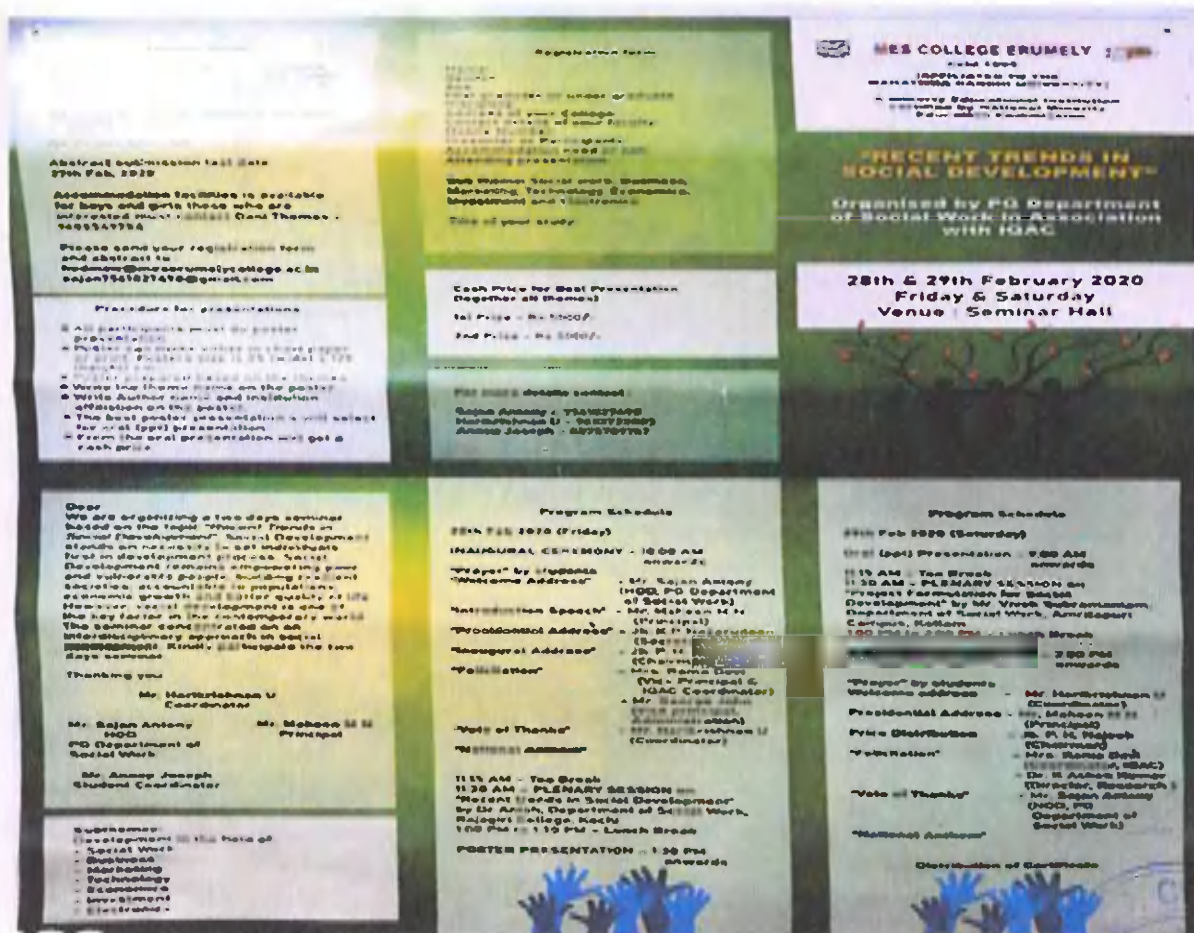

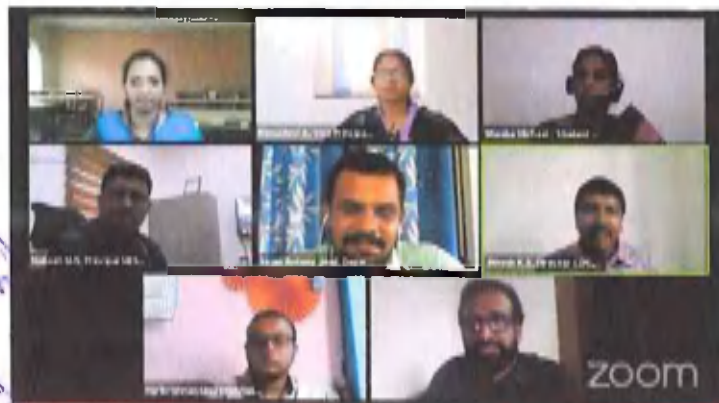

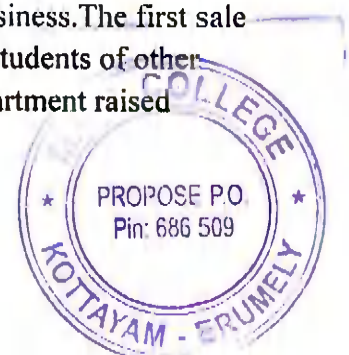


SALE OF MASKS

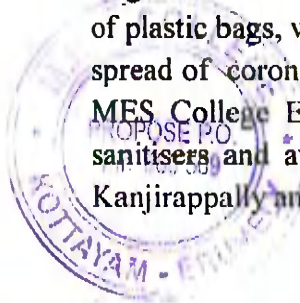


Pic 3 : Mask selling committee at selling point

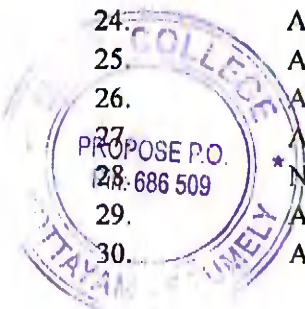
"HAIR WE SHARE": HAIR DONATION CAMPAIGN

SAKHI SAHELI

Sakhi Saheli is an initiative by the social arm of MES College Erumely, since 2017 which conceived and performed by the students of the institute. This program is synonymous with concern, care, respect and companionship, with a human touch. The goal of this initiative is to learn from the empowered women from Kudumbashree, thus nourishing the knowledge and experiences of students and also it is an initiative that reaches out to the disenfranchising women and needy. Over the years, this activity of MSW students has become more organized and consolidated. This is considered as a great opportunity for the students to engage with empowered women even though they are vulnerable.

The focus is to serve the women who are underprivileged. We, as a team, have a mission to accomplish not only empowerment or nourishment and physical presence but also to share our happiness with them. Our vision is the empowerment of women in rural as well as urban areas, bringing women together from all spheres of life to fight for their rights or for empowerment and also to develop skill among them. Empowerment of women and their participation in the development process has been considered an essential feature of development. It is presumed that real development is possible only if the women and men work in equal terms. Empowerment of women is recognized globally as a key element to achieve progress in all areas. Rural women are regarded as voiceless and defenceless. So they are to be empowered to fight against the evils faced by them. Kudumbashree project was started in Kerala in 1998. Women empowerment is one of the important objectives of Kudumbashree along with poverty eradication. The aim of the Kudumbashree scheme is to improve the standard of living of poor women in rural areas by setting up micro-credit and productive enterprises. It opened a new string of expected events in our development history. Kudumbashree is the poverty eradication mission of the state of Kerala and also women want to identify their inner strength, opportunities for growth and their role in reshaping their own destiny through Kudumbashree.

The mission of this initiative is to educate and empower women, with the skills and confidence, create a healthy lifestyle and acquaint the learners with the various social problems faced by



women that often come across by given extension field work activity and to reach the root cause of these problems. In this manner the learners are encouraged to apply their theoretical knowledge in practice.

The objective of the initiative is to understand the nature of collectivisation among Kudumbashree members, to identify the key thematic areas which need intervention through the preliminary study, to develop and implement plan of action for the challenges identified during the study, to analyse on how Kudumbashree empowering the women among the poor to improve their individual and collective capabilities by organising them into Neighbourhood Groups at the local level, Area Development Societies at the local government ward level and Community Development Societies at the local government level, also to develop skill in them, standing together and never giving up even when all odds stand in their way, to study the structure, functions and process of Kudumbashree and convergence of services at local level and how far they have been incorporated in the overall programme, to study the measures taken by Kudumbashree for economic empowerment of women with special focus on micro-credit and micro-enterprises development, to study how the Kudumbashree programme enhanced the decision making leadership and political empowerment of women.

As part of Masters of Social Work external activity, the Department of Social work directed the students to do their field work in different Kudumbashree units. The students got the opportunity to do external field work in various Kudumbashree, which has been contributing in the field of women empowerment and poverty alleviation. Through this field work the student social workers got an opportunity to know more about the Kudumbashree.

Students engage in various programmes that are assets in rural as well as in urban areas for the development and empowerment of women and thus strengthening families. These programmes in general help to motivate these women in bringing out their inborn skills and employ it to create a stream of earning. Many of the beneficiaries of these programmes, who have gone to do well in their area of interest. It is essential to mention here that the programmes have been highly successful in instilling in the beneficiaries self-worth and self-confidence, which has enriched them to earn better positive acceptance and stature in their families as well as in their communities. This is a brief glimpse into the various activities that have been implemented: Skill training on reed craft, tailoring, manufacturing of handicrafts, organic farming and creation of jewellery. The students conducted workshops and awareness classes subsequently understanding those particular Kudumbashree units.

Every year, the Masters of Social Work student's successfully complete field level intervention with Kudumbashree members. This field work gave the students a wonderful opportunity to understand more about the agency, especially their programs and developments. The trainees could fulfil most of the objectives of fieldwork which was given by the department

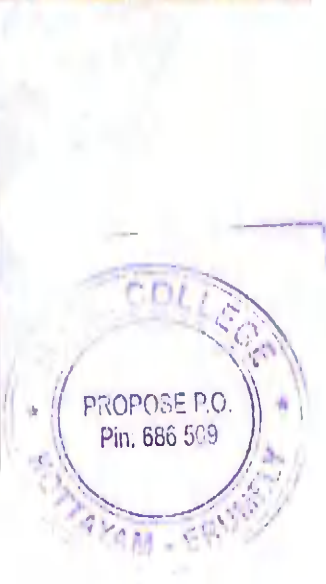
